## APPLICATION PROCESS AND GUIDELINES FOR LOADING AND HAULAGE

Step 1	<ul> <li>The applicant makes enquiry at the Commerce Department of the Ministry of Industry, Third Floor, Jerome Udoji Secretariat Complex Aroma, Awka</li> <li>The applicant fill out an enquiry form with details of his requirements at no cost.</li> <li>Commerce Department at the Ministry provides list of credible suppliers</li> </ul>
Step 2	<ul> <li>The applicant make contact with his preferred supplier. (This can be either by phone, email or physical.)</li> <li>The Applicant verify authenticity and condition of products / goods.</li> <li>The Applicant makes payment either through bank deposit, KTT or mobile app</li> <li>The applicant provides proof of payment to the supplier.</li> </ul>

Step 3	<ul> <li>LOADING AND OFFLOADING (Commence the packing and loading of the products from the suppliers warehouse)</li> <li>For this step, the following tariff are applicable statewide:</li> <li>Government has deferred all applicable fees</li> <li>Service Delivery Timeline</li> <li>We aim to ensure transactions are concluded within 3-5 Working Days prior to the final stage for haulage described in step 4.</li> </ul>
Step 4	HAULAGE

• After products have been loaded at the designated warehouse, the loaded vehicle begins its transit out of the state.

 $\circ$  At the exit borders of the state, a haulage fee is paid to government designated agents.
