## B-FEES PAYABLE IN CIVIL APPEALS FROM THE MAGISTRATES COURTS

1. Magistrate's Court Law on filing a notice of appeal: the same fee as is chargeable on the summons on commencement of the suit to which the application or appeal relates
2. In respect of any other matter or service the following fees shall be paid:
a) Where the matter or service is to be done or rendered in the Magistrates Court; the same fees as would be payable if the case were still pending before that court;
b) Where the matter or service is to be done or rendered in the High Court, subject to this qualification, namely, that where various fees are provided for the same matter or service, the lowest rate shall be charged

## PART 11- ALLOWANCE TO WITNESSES

Professional men, recognised and traditional rulers, pilots, mercantile agents, bank managers, surveyors, and officer in the public service whose net income is not less than 100 per a year.

No allowance is payable personally to an officer of the public service who is summoned as a witness by the state or by any Department of the Government.

Allowances payable to an officer in the public service shall be paid into revenue unless otherwise ordered.

## ANAMBRA STATE PROPERTY AND LAND USE CHARGE (APLUC) TAX

The following formula shall be used to determine the annual amount of the Land Use Charge payable under the Law:

$R R=$ The rate of relief from the Land Use Charge which is the general relief in addition to any of the qualified specific relief that may be granted by the Chairman Anambra State Internal Revenue Service upon application by an eligible property owner as stipulated in Appendix 11.
